



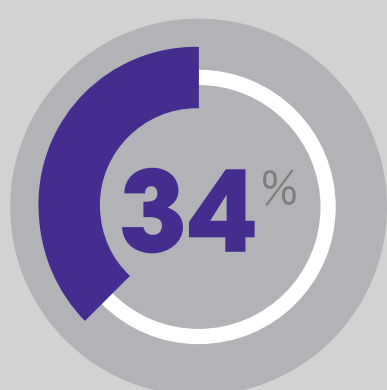

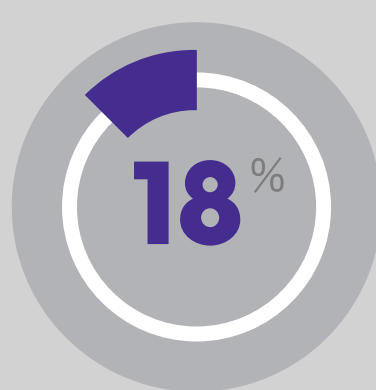


Did you know that almost
